PARK HOURS

Participants will arrive at a pre-designated time and may park hop during this time. However, Participants must be inside Disneyland California Adventure by 10pm on Saturday May 30. At this time, the gates will be locked and no Participants will be allowed in or out of the park.

DRESS CODE

All apparel must be in good condition (excessively ripped or torn jeans, shirts, etc. are prohibited) and extremely revealing clothing is not allowed.

PROHIBITED ITEMS (PLEASE INITIAL)

- Pets (Service animals are permitted and must be wearing an identifying assistive companion vest; pets may be kept at the on-site kennel)
- Wagons
- Skateboards
- Scooters (motorized and non-motorized)
- Inline skates
- Shoes with built-in wheels
- Bicycles
- Motorcycles
- Tricycles
- Unicycles
- Pogo Sticks
- 2-wheeled vehicles, including Segway Human Transporters
- Strollers larger than 36"x 52"
- Suitcases, backpacks, or similar bags with wheels
- Suitcases, backpacks or similar bags larger than 18' wide x 25'high x37' deep (the size of large rentable lockers at the park)
- Any trailer-like object that is pushed or towed by an ECV, wheelchair or stroller

***Note: Guests are not permitted to pull items behind them. Any item that requires a Guest to pull it behind him or her, including a stroller, is not permitted into the theme parks.**

- Alcoholic Beverages
- Any illegal substances
- Folding chairs, with the exception of cane-chair and seat-walker mobility aids
- Glass containers with the exception of small perfume bottles
- Costumes on guests older than age 9, except during special events that permit children up to age 12 to wear costumes
- Water pistols, toy guns and replica weapons with the exception of those sold in the *Disneyland*® Resort
- Sporting goods or equipment (e.g., baseball bats, helmets, hockey sticks, golf clubs, bows and arrows, camping equipment, chairs, stools, tables and Frisbees)
